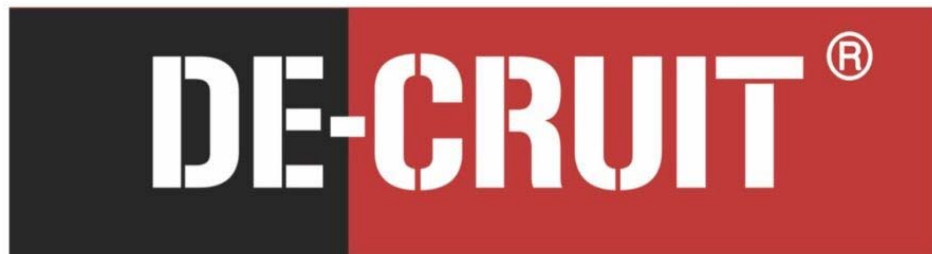
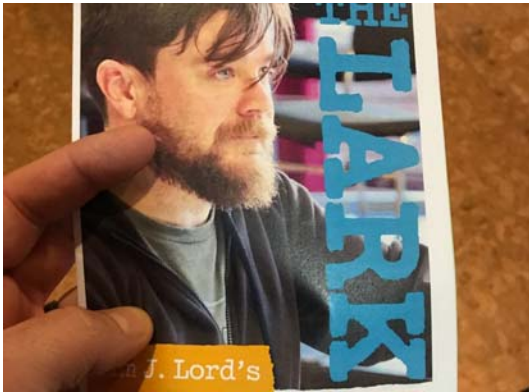

From Boulder to Milwaukee via NYC
